We also provided opportunities with coaches for girls who were interested in taking part in football. 10 KS2 girls attended a football festival with Coalville Ravens as well as all KS2 having the chance to meet 2 Leicester City Women's Players and their coach. 26 girls had a coaching session with the LCWF coach and the 2 professional players.
