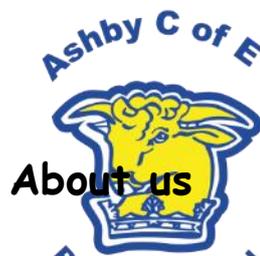

Ashby C. E. Primary School was built in 1910 and is one of four primary schools in Ashby. There are currently 316 children on roll, in eleven classes. Key Stage One and Years 3 and 4 are housed in the main building, Foundation Stage are located in our fantastic new building and Years 5 and 6 in the mobiles. Within the main building we also have a well used library, ICT suite, hall and children's kitchen. Outside, a large "L" shaped playground is complemented with a quiet area, peace garden, pond, kitchen garden, adventure trail and playing field.

At Ashby, we strongly believe that children come first and this is reflected in the every day life of all the children at our school. We have adopted an Assertive Discipline approach to behaviour, which supports our belief in rewarding and encouraging achievements of all kinds.

The school has a caring, dedicated, friendly staff, committed to the need to raise standards and expectations amongst our children. We focus on challenging all our children and our staff enjoy thinking creatively about how to deliver the curriculum.

The school adopts an "open door" policy and parents are encouraged to work in partnership with the school. We have an active parent teacher association and throughout the year, they plan and organise fund raising events to support the purchase of much valued extra resources for the children. Parents are also encouraged to play a supportive role in the learning environment and many help in school with reading, cooking, art, craft and other activities.
