We have a vacancy for an SEN Learning Support Assistant.
This is a temporary position for 1 term (until 18.12.26) for 13.5hrs per week. Hours will be split between both AM & PM sessions (eg: 2 x AMs, 2 x PMs and 1 full day).

The role will encompass dedicated 1:1 support to identified children, delivering personalised assistance in line with their individual needs, and to implement the specific outcomes, strategies, and provision set out within their Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP). This role will also include supporting home learning.



An SEN LSA will work under the direct supervision of a teacher to provide support for teaching and learning and associated activities in accordance with school policies and procedures.

Ashby C. E. Primary School was built in 1910 and is one of four primary schools in Ashby. We have 11 classes; Key Stage One and Years 3 and 4 are housed in the main building, Foundation Stage are located in our fantastic new building and Years 5 and 6 in the mobiles. Within the main building we also have a beautiful library and through school, we have spaces for nurture provision and a specialised classroom, the Ark, for focused interventions. Outside, a large "L" shaped playground is complemented with a quiet area, peace garden, pond, adventure trail and playing field.
